Also on display at the entrance of the event are a multitude of current Navy jets and helicopters, special boats and hovercraft, as well as vintage aircraft, with the crews eager to answer questions and allow access into the aircraft.

Tickets will also be available at the venue (\$30 for one day and \$40 for both days). Children 12 and under are free with paid adult admission.
