**MAYOR JERRY SANDERS REAPPOINTS
CHARLES WESLEY KIM, JR. TO POLICE REVIEW BOARD**

Attorney for Yelman & Associates Looks Forward to Reprising His Role

SAN DIEGO, July 30, 2008 – Charles Wesley Kim Jr., Of Counsel to Yelman & Associates, has been reappointed by Mayor Jerry Sanders to another one-year term on the Citizens’ Review Board on Police Practices. He has served on the Board since July of 2006.

The Board reviews citizen complaints, officer-involved shootings and in-custody deaths involving the San Diego Police Department. The Board is an independent citizens’ group comprised of 23 members who represent a diverse cross section of San Diego’s citizens. Its purpose is to assure that complaints against San Diego Police Officers are investigated thoroughly, completely and fairly. The Board also recommends and advocates policies which promote fair and human policing of the city.

Kim is extensively involved in community and legal affairs in San Diego, serving on the City’s Managed Competition Independent Review Board, County Assessment Appeals Board No. 4, County Bar Association Board of Directors, and Judicial Council’s Commission for Impartial Courts.

Previously, Kim was an Adjunct Professor at the University of San Diego, Thomas Jefferson and California Western Schools of Law. He is also a past President of the Pan Asian Lawyers of San Diego and Asian Pacific Bar of California.
